



CONTINUOUS PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT (CPD) POLICY

Continuous Professional Development (CPD) is an essential component for all IASF qualified saddle fitters. The purpose of CPD is to constantly develop and further your skills and to ensure your knowledge base is up to date in this rapidly evolving industry.

This policy is reviewed and reissued annually and is subject to change based on the requirements set out by the IASF board.

IASF strive for excellence and as a representative of this awarding body each qualified member is required to undertake a minimum amount of CPD annually. Additional to this each qualified member is required to undertake a formal reassessment of skill every 12 months following their initial practical training.

The current annual prescribed CPD requirement is as follows:

Open	Saddle Fitting Related	30

The total amount of CPD undertaken should be equal to (or greater than) 36 hours per annum which includes a CPD reassessment day held by IASF.

The remaining 30 hours can be split over the year and should cover a range of topics such as:

- Saddle tree types (manufacturer visits)
- Anatomy and Physiology
- Gait Analysis
- Palpation Techniques
- Reading research papers
- Watching relevant educational videos
- Pathology
- Shadowing other saddle fitters

All CPD undertaken must be recorded and submitted to IASF using the attached form.
